



How-To Guide: connecting mobile devices to displays

Apple Devices

- Connecting to newer displays: Connect your Apple device to an HDTV or HDMI compatible projector or display using an AV cable, available here. Supported devices include: iPad (all generations), iPhone 4, iPhone 4S, iPod touch (4th generation).
- Connecting to older displays: Connect your Apple device to a television, projector, or other VGA compatible display using a VGA adaptor, available here.² Supported devices include: iPad (all generations), iPhone 4, iPhone 4S, iPod touch (4th generation).
- Connecting to Apple TV: Connect your Apple device to a display by using Airplay mirroring with Apple TV. Detailed instructions are available here.³ Supported devices: iPhone 4S or iPad 2 (and later) with iOS 5 and later.

Android Devices

- Android devices with HDMI ports connect directly to computer monitors, televisions and projectors with HDMI inputs via an HDMI cable. Please refer to your Android owner's manual for details.
- Some Android devices can output to displays from the headphone jack using a **custom cable**. Please refer to your Android owner's manual for details.
